St. James Town Service Providers' Network

The St. James Town Service Providers' Network consists of service providers and community members who work collaboratively to develop and implement a coordinated plan for a vibrant, safe and healthy community.

The St. James Town Service Providers' Network (SPN) was formed in response to requests from community groups to address coordination and service planning in St. James Town. It began in 1998 as a coalition under the name St. James Town Working Group (SJTWG). By mid-2006, the coalition was represented by over 20 social, health and educational organizations. In the fall of 2008, the group was renamed the St. James Town Service Providers' Network, developing Terms of Reference that reflected their mission, goals and objectives.

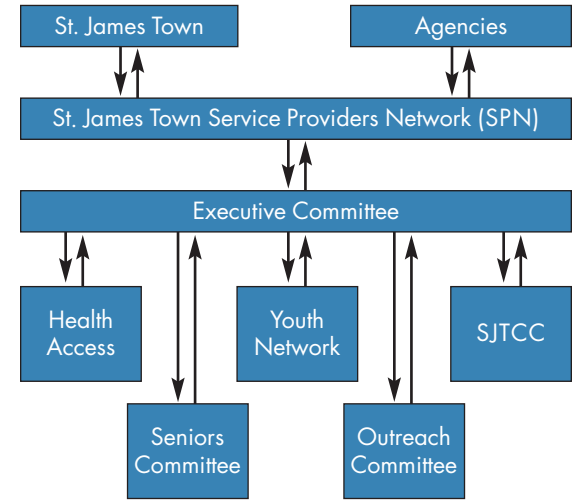
OBJECTIVES

CURRENT STRUCTURE OF THE SPN



SPN:

Staff meet monthly to provide opportunities for service coordination, information sharing and cross-sectoral planning

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

Co-chair and one lead of the sub-committees/working group meet monthly or as needed to coordinate the subcommittees' action plan, and lead the SPN vision and goals.

SUB-COMMITTEES:

Lead of the sub-committee/working group meet monthly or as needed in order to develop and coordinate plans to achieve outcomes set by the group.
