- Commitment of 3-5 hours per week
- Honoraria provided only for specific projects

What is the criteria for participating?

- Must be a resident of St. James Town and surrounding area
- Preference will be given to residents living in the 19 high-rise buildings
- Must be proficient in English
- Must be available to attend the trainings
