A SHARED EFFORT

The success of the Corner was made possible by Toronto Community Housing, which made the space available to the community, provided staff assistance and a Social Investment Fund grant to support governance training. Agency partners have committed time and resources and funding to renovate the space was obtained from the Trillium Foundation, Manulife Financial, Home Depot, Sherbourne Health Centre and Stuff Canada. The Corner will need continued support from agencies, governments, foundations, businesses and residents.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SPACE

Application forms for service providers and for individuals and community groups are available on the web-site and there is a review process to make sure that any use fits with the values and policies of The Corner and that it can work with the schedule. The Corner has final approval on all applications. Every individual, group or organization that uses the space must abide by the City of Toronto's Non Discrimination, Anti-Racism and Access and Equity policies, and with the St. James Town Community Corner's Users Bill of Rights and Anti-Oppression Policy. The Corner is here for everyone to feel safe, accepted and respected.
